Our young people are experiencing a media environment that is increasingly violent, commercialised, and sexualised. They will be joined by Australians **Professor Louise Newman** (sexualisation of children), **Dr Wayne Warburton** (violent music videos), **Dr Cordelia Fine** (children's understanding of advertising) and **Professor Elizabeth Handsley** (the role of regulation and classification).

This is almost certainly the most powerful selection of experts across a range of crucial media issues ever assembled for such a seminar in Australia.
